

Church Services, Bible Studies, Prayer Groups

- Various area and lay ministers present scripture-based sermons every Sunday at 8:30am at the "come as you are" services. Many audio sermons are available on our web site.
- Communion is open to all believers the first Sunday every month, and in the front room other Sundays.
- The congregation selects gospel favorites to sing.
- A donation basket is available next to the sign-in register, instead of a standard offering. Donations are used for area residents in need, to help maintain the church, and other special ministries.
- Free Bibles, Christian books, sermon CDs, and cards are available next to the front door.
- The Women's Prayer Group meets the 1st and 3rd Monday at 6:00pm at the church, excluding holidays.
- The Women's Bible Study meets the 2nd Monday at 10:00am at various homes.
- The Men's Bible Study meets the 3rd Thursday at 6:00pm at various homes.
- Special Bible Studies also meet at the church.

History & Beliefs

- In 1896, Mathis Splitlog built the church for his wife, and wanted it to be used to worship God.
- In the 1980's and 1990's, the Grand Lake Ministries conducted church services in the Church on Sundays from Memorial Day through Labor Day.
- In 1999, after the Grand Lake Ministries discontinued services, three families worked with the church owner and other generous persons to enable services to be held year around.
- The non-denominational church family believes:
 - The Bible is the inspired word of God.
 - Jesus Christ, the Son of God, lived on earth, was crucified on the cross for the redemption of our sins, was resurrected into Heaven, and resides at the right hand of God the Father.
 - The Holy Trinity: God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
 - Jesus is coming again.

Directions

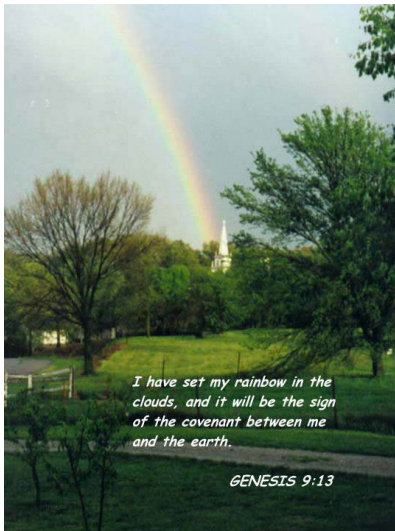
- From downtown Grove, OK, intersection of Highways 59 & 10 (3rd Street & Main), go east about 3 miles to the intersection where Highway 10 turns north.
- Go north on Highway 10 for about 3.5 miles to Road E260, which is just past the Cowskin Prairie Restaurant.
- At Road E260 and the Cayuga Mission Church sign, go east for about 2 miles. Road E260 ends where it goes into the lake. Turn right (south) onto Road 670. In a couple of blocks, you can see the Church.
